ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 21, 2016:

ORD. NO. 77-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, with the County of Summit and neighboring communities for their participation in the 2016 Street Resurfacing Program, in which neighboring communities and the County will share in the cost of improving streets that run along and partially outside the corporate limites of the City, in order to improve roadway safety, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objective of encouraging fair and effective intergovernmental cooperation for the benefit of the Akron community; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 78-2016 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Kenmore Construction Company for the emergency repair of the 8-inch water main at the intersection of Copley Road and Frederick Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 79-2016 authorizing the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Catholic Charities Community Services Corporation for operation of the summer recreation program for youth with disabilities, in order to support this successful and valuable program for the benefit of the disabled youth in our community; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 80-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Rolta AdvizeX, LLC for archiving and storage services for City emails, in order to enable the City to upgrade and maintain the City's email archiving system and ensure that the City remains in compliance with applicable laws regarding record retention; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 81-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Taser International for the purchase and trade-in of taser equipment, to ensure that the Akron Police Division is equipped with appropriate, updated safety gear and to save taxpayer money by taking advantage of a discount offered by Taser International; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
