## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 11, 2016:**

**RES. NO. 101-2016** declaring it necessary to improve West Emerling Avenue between the termini of Firestone Parkway and South Main Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 102-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into contracts using Community University Education Purchasing Association (CUE) bids, National Joint Powers Association (NJPA) bids or State of Ohio bids, or after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in the daily operations of the Department of Public Service, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of supporting operational efficiency and productivity by upgrading and replacing obsolete equipment and reducing the downtime and repair costs associated with maintenance-intensive equipment; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 103-2016** authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into grant agreements for funding from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, through the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance to Firefighters Program, and to enter into contracts to implement the grant agreement; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds; all in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of replacing obsolete vehicles and equipment in order to provide for the health and safety of Akron citizens; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 104-2016** authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court, in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of the United States with respect to the provision of legal representation to indigent defendants and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of advancing the efficient administration of justice; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 105-2016** authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$5,000,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of a court approved settlement and a final judgement rendered against the City by the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division in the case William Howe, et all. V. City of Akron, Case No. 5:06-cv-2779; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 106-2016** approving the 2016 Consolidated Action Plan including applications and certifications for the Community Development Block Grant (“Community Development”), the HOME Investment Partnership (“HOME”) and Emergency Solutions Grant (“ESG”) Programs, authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Programs, all in furtherance with Mayor Horrigan’s objectives of developing affordable housing and providing assistance to low and middle income Akron residents to enable the rehabilitation of existing housing, preventing and combating homelessness, stabilizing at-risk neighborhoods, mobilizing community resources, and expanding and renewing economic opportunity for Akron residents; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 107-2016** determining to proceed with the improvement of Exchange Street between the termini of South Portage Path and Arc Drive and Cedar Street between the termini of West Exchange Street and South Broadway Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
