ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 23, 2016:

ORD. NO. 165-2016 creating, establishing, and recognizing departments, offices, bureaus, divisions and positions in the classified service of the City of Akron; requiring that only budgeted funded positions be filled; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 166-2016 approving the sale of 0.26 acres of City-owned land at 303 Litchfield Road to Andrew E. Taylor, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the land and to reduce the City's costs in maintaining vacant lots; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 167-2016 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 168-2016 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the State of Ohio's FY2017 Ohio Airport Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 169-2016 amending and/or supplementing Title 11 "Business Regulations," Chapter 111 "Regulations Governing Specific Business," Section 111.008 "Charge for hospital transports" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron, to rename Section 111.008 "Charges for emergency medical services and other public safety services" and to adjust the rate charged for life support services, transportation, and other public safety services, to bring the fees charged in the City of Akron in line with those charged in surrounding communities and to account for the rising cost of providing these services; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 170-2016 accepting a vacation plat for a dedicated utility right-of-way containing 0.34 acres of land; and a dedication plat for a utility right-of-way containing 0.24 acres of land located on the east side of Ghent Road, north of Smith Road; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 171-2016 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2016 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 172-2016 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2016 Phase II Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 173-2016 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2016 Phase II Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 174-2016 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2016 Phase II Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 175-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2016 Residential Resurfacing Phase II Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 176-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2016 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Phase I Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 177-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2016 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Phase II Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 178-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2016 Arterial Collector Resurfacing Phase I Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 179-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2016 Arterial Collector Resurfacing Phase II Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 180-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the County of Summit for the City 2016 Construction Seal and Crack Filling program, in order to improve roadway safety and engage in fair and cost-effective intergovernmental cooperation and collaboration for the benefit of Akron residents; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 181-2016 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2016 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 182-2016 authorizing the Mayor, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, using State Term or CUE bids, for the purchase of an Elevated Stream Pumper for Station No. 5 and to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the equipment and tools needed to equip the Elevated Stream Pumper; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Fusco not in seat)*

ORD. NO. 183-2016 authorizing the Mayor, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after accepting informal sealed bids, for the purchase of uniform materials for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 184-2016 urging Akron residents to volunteer with the City's Summer Reading Program, June 6 through August 18, to combat "summer slide" and help Akron students maintain and enhance reading achievement over the summer; and urging all parents, guardians and youth of the City of Akron to take advantage of the Summer Reading Program, by contacting their local Community Center; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
