ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 13, 2016:

ORD. NO. 193-2016 authorizing the purchase of a Sewer Easement for the CSO Rack 5/7 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 194-2016 approving the donation of 964 Greenwood Ave. to Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 195-2016 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 196-2016 determining to proceed with the improvement of West Emerling Avenue between the termini of Firestone Parkway and South Main Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 197-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts with Schultz Fluid Handling, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the replacement of one sludge pump and the upgrade of a second sludge pump at the Water Reclamation Facility; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 198-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for microresurfacing of Tallmadge Avenue between Main Street and Route 8 and other locations, in order to enable further study of the impacts of the complete streets road diet through the corridor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 199-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Taser International for the purchase and trade-in of taser equipment, to ensure that the Akron Police Division is equipped with appropriate, updated safety gear; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

RES. NO. 200-2016 expressing the deep and sincere sympathy and compassion of the City of Akron to the families and loved ones of the victims of the tragic shooting at the Pulse nightclub in Orlando, Florida; extending heartfelt wishes for strength and healing to the individuals and communities impacted by this devastating and senseless act of hate and terror; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*
