ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 12, 2016:

ORD. NO. 270-2016 authorizing the Mayor to file an application with assurances and certifications with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Continuum of Care Application for Stewart B. McKinney funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Freeman & Omobien abstained)***

ORD. NO. 271-2016 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into contract with the Board of Education of the Akron Public School District for the Community Learning Centers After School Program to provide after school learning and enrichment activities; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 272-2016 imposing a moratorium on the issuance or processing of any license, building permit, certificate of occupancy, conditional use or other authorization that would enable the cultivation, processing, or dispensing of medical marijuana within the City of Akron for a period of one-year, in order to enable the City to study and review the new Ohio Medical Marijuana Law and other applicable zoning, business, and criminal laws and regulations, and recommended the appropriate action to be taken regarding local regulation or prohibition of such activity within the City, in order to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 273-2016 determining to proceed with the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 171-2016 (2016 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

NO. 274-2016 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 172-2016, to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2016 Phase II Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
