ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 19, 2016:

ORD. NO. 278-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after obtaining quotes, to enter into a contract with Houston Radar for 10 bi-directional, traffic data gathering radar devices for use by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS); and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 279-2016 approving the donation of City -owned land at 88 Oakdale Avenue to West Hill Neighborhood Organization, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the land as community open space; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 280-2016 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application and enter into an agreement with the County of Summit for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families and Prevention, Retention and Contingency services; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into agreements to implement these services; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 281-2016 declaring it necessary to improve Maryland Avenue between the termini of 4th Street and 9th Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 282-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for concrete repairs on Interstate 77; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 283-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for guardrail upgrades on State Route 8; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 284-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to State Route 91 by resurfacing; requesting the Director of Transportation to proceed with the project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 285-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to Tallmadge Avenue (State Route 261); requesting the Director of Transportation to proceed with the project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 286-2016 determining to proceed with the improvement of Hampton Ridge Drive between the western terminus on Smith Road and the eastern terminus on Smith Road by paving; grading;

constructing and reconstructing curbs and driveway approaches; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 287-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, having obtained quotes, to enter into a contract with Cenweld Corporation for the purchase and installation of a stake bed and equipment to be installed on an existing truck chassis, for use by the Communications Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 288-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for security upgrades and repairs to the entry gates at the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 289-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of various primary tank parts for the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 290-2016 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land on Nome, Ripley, and Grand Avenues, pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**
(Freeman abstained)

ORD. NO. 291-2016 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 292-2016 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 293-2016 expressing the sincere sympathy of the City of Akron to the family and loved ones of Pastor Dennis K. Butts, Sr. on the occasion of his passing; and expressing appreciation for his many years of service to the Akron community; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**
