ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 17, 2016:

ORD. NO. 316-2016 authorizing the Clerk of the Akron Municipal Court to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Mapsys, Inc. for the purpose of maintaining and repairing various existing hardware systems including the upkeep and repair of hard drives, consoles, tape libraries, printers, controllers, servicer licenses and other server components. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 317-2016 accepting property by donation for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 318-2016 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 319-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract without the formality of advertising for bids, with Teledyne Instruments, Inc. for the purchase of a Fusion UV Persulfate TOC Analyzer Unit for the Water Plant laboratory from a sole source vendor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 320-2016 providing that any employee hired by the City of Akron and any official elected or appointed by the City of Akron on or after January 1, 2017, shall not receive any health care, vision or dental benefits from the City of Akron upon retirement from the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Fusco & Hoch abstained)***
