## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 21, 2016:**

**ORD. NO. 366-2016** approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 367-2016** declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Ascot Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Woodridge Local School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 368-2016** declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Furnace-Howard Urban Renewal Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 369-2016** declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Sweitzer Development Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 370-2016** authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program services and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 371-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts after publicly advertising for bids for the disposal of miscellaneous large metal appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners, washers, dryers, freezers, dehumidifiers, and stoves collected as part of the City of Akron's Curbservice Program and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 372-2016** authorizing the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Fallsway Equipment Co. for the purchase of a refurbished lift truck (tow motor) for use by the Division of Motor Equipment so as to permit shop personnel to continue to perform their duties safely and efficiently and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 373-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for street tree trimming services; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 374-2016** to authorize the Director of Public Service, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter in a contract or contracts for the purchase of 250 tons, more or less, of Aqua Nuchar Activated Carbon from Ingevity at \$.91/lb for water treatment at the Akron Water Plant. ***VOTE: 11-0 (Sommerville not in seat)***

**ORD. NO. 375-2016** authorizing the Clerk of the Akron Municipal Court to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with MailFinance, a Neopost Company, to provide an alternative source of electronic returns for certified mail delivery on civil cases filed with the Clerk of the Akron Municipal Court and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***
