## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 30, 2017:**

**ORD. NO. 16-2017** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of liability insurance for Canal Park stadium; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 17-2017** approving the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 18-2017** authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the construction of the Howard Storage Basin (CSO Rack 22) Project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 19-2017** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after the receipt of proposals from qualified suppliers, for the purchase and installation of new field padding for the Canal Park stadium; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 20-2017** amending and/or supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 93 “Fire Prevention,” Section 73 “Permit and Fee Schedule” of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 21-2017** authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the side yard requirement to construct two additions at 1810 Ganyard Road; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 22-2017** authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an auto repair business at 2211 Manchester Road; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Freeman abstained)***

**ORD. NO. 23-2017** authorizing a Conditional Use to install a projecting sign at 1000 Kenmore Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 24-2017** urging the Ohio Department of Education to reconsider its recent proposal/ decision that no funding be allocated for new grants related to the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center programs in fiscal year 2018; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 25-2017** recognizing January 17, 2017, as the National Day of Racial Healing; acknowledging the racial healing efforts of certain community institutions and encouraging all citizens of Akron to actively promote racial healing throughout the duration of 2017; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 26-2017** expressing opposition to President Trump's administrative order dated January 27, 2017, which among other things, unilaterally bans immigrant and nonimmigrant entry into the United States, regardless of lawful permanent residency status or valid visas, suspends the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program and precludes other individuals from entry into the U.S.; expressing support for those affected individuals attempting to gain what would be otherwise legal access to the United States; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
