ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 20, 2017:

ORD. NO. 69-2017 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept grant funding from the Knight Foundation to support an Akron Smart City IoT (Internet of Things) Technology Initiative; authorizing the expenditure of the grant funds; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 70-2017 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept grant funding from the ArtPlace America 2017 National Creative Placemaking Fund; authorizing the expenditure of the grant funds; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 71-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of roofing services from Damschroder Roofing, Inc. for the Municipal Service Center Building #3; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 72-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Norris Brothers Co., Inc., for purchasing of parts, materials, and labor, for removal of the existing sole plate, and the installation of a new sole plate for High Service Pump Four at Water Supply; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 73-2017 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court, in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of the United States with respect to the provision of legal representation to indigent defendants and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of advancing the efficient administration of justice; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 74-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an independent adult living facility at the southeast corner of the intersection of Mull Avenue and White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 75-2017 opposing any federal budget cuts that would reduce and/or eliminate the funding available for the Community Development Block Grant program ("CDBG"), including the HOME Investment Partnerships program ("HOME"); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 76-2017 expressing opposition to the American Health Care Act draft legislation ("AHCA"); urging Congress to maintain key components of the Affordable Care Act ("ACA"); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 77-2017 opposing certain federal budget cuts proposed in President Trump's "America's First Budget" proposal (the "Budget Proposal"); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**
