## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 13, 2017:**

**ORD. NO. 64-2017** approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***

**ORD. NO. 65-2017** pursuant to Section 70.52 (B) of the Code of Ordinances, approving the change of ownership of Johnny's Auto and Truck Towing, Inc., and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***

**ORD. NO. 66-2017** authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$4,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay expenses associated with the settlement of health care claims, whether by reserve or otherwise, and the City's portion of the costs of maintaining its self-insurance program for employee health care benefits; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***

**ORD. NO. 67-2017** authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept grant funding from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) through their 'Overage' grant funds to support an Akron Youth Violence Facilitator to help prevent youth violence in Akron; authorizing the expenditure of the grant funds; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***

**RES. NO. 68-2017** opposing and objecting to the transfer application of LG & H ENT, LLC, D/B/A Game 7 Bar & Grille, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor & Patio, 627 S. Arlington Street, Akron, Ohio 44306 for the transfer of a Class D5 liquor permit (5180405) to be pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***
