ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 27, 2017:

ORD. NO. 78-2017 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Delaware Avenue at the intersection of Delaware Avenue and Newport Road; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 79-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for roof shingle replacement at the Lawton Street Community Center; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 80-2017 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Northeast Ohio Basketball Association for the management, promotion and operation of the Dru Joyce Shooting Stars Classic; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 81-2017 expressing appreciation to Ellet High School Football Coach Joe Yost for his many years of dedicated service to the City of Akron as a teacher, coach, and mentor in the Ellet Community; congratulating him on his record-breaking career and wishing him well in his retirement; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 82-2017 amending/supplementing Title 3 “Administration,” Chapter 34 “Public Contracts and Property,” Sections 34.01 “Definitions,” 34.02 “Administration,” and 34.03 “Equal employment opportunity clause,” and adopting Title 3 “Administration,” Chapter 38 “Unlawful Discrimination” of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to adopt comprehensive non-discrimination provisions for the City of Akron related to employment, housing, and public accommodations, and to create the Akron Civil Rights Commission to enforce complaints of such unlawful discrimination in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 83-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with CI Technologies, Inc., for the purchase of IAPro software and associated services; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 84-2017 expressing to Connie Genevish the sincere gratitude of the Council, the Mayor and the people of the city of Akron for her career of service and dedication to the City; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
