

AKRON CITY COUNCIL
New Legislation List-June 19, 2017

PLANNING:

1. Ordinance approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

2. Ordinance approving and authorizing the execution of an option agreement and a purchase agreement with Equinox Capital Group, LLC or its designee, providing for the sale of City-owned property; and declaring an emergency.

3. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a real property lease agreement with Arizona Facilities Supply, LLC or its designee; and declaring an emergency.

3A. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file applications and to enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements under the Ohio Public Works Commission's Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) and State Capital Improvements Program (SCIP); committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES:

4. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Metrohm USA Inc. for the purchase of an Ion Chromatograph for laboratory EPA regulatory testing at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & JOB CREATION:

5. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into and execute the Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing; and declaring an emergency.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE:

6. Resolution approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of GinaKaye Maddox, Nanette Pitt, Brant Lee, Eufancia Lash, and Cynthia Christman as members of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of Sharon Connor and John Alvarez Turner as alternate members of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and declaring an emergency.
