ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 26, 2017:

ORD 201-2017 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 202-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Metrohm USA Inc. for the purchase of an Ion Chromatograph for laboratory EPA regulatory testing at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 203-2017 approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of GinaKaye Maddox, Nanette Pitt, Brant Lee, Eufancia Lash, and Cynthia Christman as members of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of Sharon Connor and John Alvarez Turner as alternate members of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 204-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a medical marijuana cultivation and processing site on the south side of Harlem Road (Parcel Nos. 6852309 and 6857723); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 205-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation site at 1956 South Main Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 206-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation and processing site at 1055 Home Avenue; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD 207-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation and processing site at 171 Kelly Avenue; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 208-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation site at 1023/1025 South Broadway; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 209-2017 approving and authorizing the execution of an option agreement and a purchase agreement with Equinox Capital Group, LLC or its designee, providing for the sale of City-owned property; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal and Mosley Samples abstained)**

ORD 210-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a real property lease agreement with Arizona Facilities Supply, LLC or its designee; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Mosley Samples abstained)**

RES 211-2017 opposing any federal or state legislation or proposal that would reduce Medicaid funding/benefits, which would in turn drastically increase the number of uninsured individuals and deepen the opioid crisis, among other things; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 212-2017 expressing support for prospective medical marijuana cultivators in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**
