

AKRON CITY COUNCIL
New Legislation List-July 3, 2017

PLANNING:

1. Ordinance approving the 2017 Consolidated Action Plan including applications and certifications for the Community Development Block Grant (“Community Development”), the HOME Investment Partnership (“HOME”) and Emergency Solutions Grant (“ESG”) Programs; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Programs; and declaring an emergency. *(Public hearing scheduled for 7/10/17)*

2. Ordinance accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Allyn Street, north of East South Street; and declaring an emergency.

3. Ordinance approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan’s objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

4. Ordinance authorizing the purchase of 262 Eastland Ave. and 1048 Hazel St. for the CSO Rack 10/11 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

5. Ordinance authorizing the City to donate an easement interest in City property to Children’s Hospital Medical Center of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE:

6. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into an agreement or agreements with the Ohio Director of Transportation for Maintenance of the Interstates located within the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES:

7. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with i2c Technologies for the purchase and installation of a security surveillance system for monitoring water storage facilities in the distribution system; and declaring an emergency.

8. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of various iron, steel, and brass parts to be used in the maintenance of the water distribution system; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

9. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with the Township of Boston Heights for the purchase of a Ford F-550 Brush Truck; and declaring an emergency.

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10. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement or agreements with the County of Summit to specify the terms of the annual Per Capita payment that is made to the City of Akron by the County of Summit; and declaring an emergency.

11. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement or agreements with the Metro Regional Transit Authority to purchase traveling billboards on metro buses to display Body-Worn Camera information; and declaring an emergency.

12. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of console equipment for police vehicles; and declaring an emergency.

13. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement for funding through the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services' 2017 Justice Assistance Grant administered through the State of Ohio; authorizing the expenditure of local funds in support of this grant; and declaring an emergency.

14. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Public Safety, for funding from the FFY 2018 Ohio Traffic Safety, Impaired Driving Enforcement Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

15. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the FFY 2018 Ohio Traffic Safety Office, Selective Traffic Enforcement Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

16. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file an application for a grant from the Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation and to accept the grant if it is awarded to the City of Akron; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement or agreements to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.
