PLANNING:

1. ORDINANCE approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement or agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Solutions Grant Program for program year 2016 authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.
3. ORDINANCE approving the sale of vacant, City-owned property; determining said property not to be needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency.
4. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to place an electronic message center sign at 534-566 White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a car wash with motor vehicle sales and storage on the east side of Home Avenue, south of Success Road; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing scheduled for 7/31/17)*
6. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct parking for an apartment development on the west side of State Road, south of Ascot Parkway; and declaring an emergency.
7. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized garage at 1670 Faye Road; and declaring an emergency.
8. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a medical marijuana cultivation facility on the east side of Baltimore Avenue, north of Georgia Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing scheduled for 7/31/17)*
9. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation facility at 1076 Home Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing scheduled for 7/31/17)*
10. ORDINANCE directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Aaron and Louise Bane, under a land contract with John Richards, Jr., located at 454 Wellington Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I, Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency.
11. ORDINANCE directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Jeannette Bray, David Maddox, Margaret Parms, Lawrence Maddox, and Leonard Maddox, located at 246 Eastland Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under

Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I; Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency.

12. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter in an agreement for the lease and sale of city-owned property to Akron Soul Train; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
13. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to sell approximately 1.4 acres of land to Ohio Pure Foods; determining that the property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE:

14. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency.
15. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of metalworking and fabrication equipment for the Motor Equipment Division; and declaring an emergency.
16. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract or contracts for the repair of the roof at Joy Park Community Center; and declaring an emergency.
17. ORDINANCE determining to proceed with the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 151-2017 (2017 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency.
18. ORDINANCE approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 149-2017 passed May 15, 2017 (the "Resolution of Necessity"), to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2017 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency.
19. ORDINANCE approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 150-2017 passed May 15, 2017 (the "Resolution of Necessity"), to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2017 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency.
20. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub

and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

MISCELLANEOUS:

21. RESOLUTION requesting that the Huntington National Bank keep its Kenmore branch open; and declaring an emergency.
