

***AKRON CITY COUNCIL***  
***New Legislation List-July 24, 2017***

**BUDGET & FINANCE:**

0. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Summit County and various other jurisdictions for the shared purchase, implementation and use of Matrix Case Management Software; and declaring an emergency.

**PLANNING:**

1. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned land on the east side of West Center Street to Akron Children's Hospital; determining said property is not needed for public use; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement to sell said property; and declaring an emergency.

2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to license or lease a portion of 952 E. Exchange Street to the Battered Women's Shelter of Summit & Medina Counties for the creation of a playground; and declaring an emergency.

3. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Summit County allowing Summit County to administer the development of the Reserve at North Revere subdivision, which has various lots located within the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE:**

4. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for improvements to State Route 8; declaring that said project is in the public interest; and declaring an emergency.

5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to apply for grant funding through AMATS for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds that are available for use in the City of Akron's complete street improvement project to North Main Street; authorizing the expenditure of local funds in support of this grant; and declaring an emergency.

6. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with D.B. Development, LLC, for the private construction of sewer improvements in Canfield Road; and declaring an emergency.

7. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Assetworks for the purchase of Fleet Focus and Maintenance Management software and/or associated services; and declaring an emergency.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

8. RESOLUTION declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate fee simple interests in real property owned by Martha M. Nelson, located at 1052 Hazel Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage, and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); and declaring an emergency.
