ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 25, 2017:

ORD 289-2017 authorizing the Clerk of the Akron Municipal Court to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Mapsys, Inc. for the purpose of providing upgrades the office's operating system; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 290-2017 approving the donation of a City-owned property; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 291-2017 approving the donation of City owned land; determining the property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 292-2017 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 293-2017 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in the emergency repair of the elevators in the Superblock Parking Deck; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 294-20107 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of LED lighting fixtures for the Cascade Parking Deck; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 295-2017 determining to proceed with the improvement of South Main Street between the termini of State Street and Mill Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, storm sewers, sanitary sewers, water mains, and utility vaults; installing street lighting and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 296-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a garage at 554 Weber Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (9/11/17) **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 297-2017 amending Ordinance No. 42-2017, passed February 13, 2017, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017 and declaring an emergency (9/18/17) **VOTE 13-0**
