ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED 11-20-17

- 1 ORD 359-2017 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 360-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract to purchase online employee benefit enrollment services through BenTek, Inc.; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 361-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts for the installation of certain sodium hypochlorite tanks at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 362-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts to purchase various equipment, materials and labor in order to upgrade and replace the current supervisory control and data acquisition system (“SCADA”) and related items at the Akron Water Plant located at 1570 Ravenna Road in Kent, Ohio; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 363-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept if awarded a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the "Safety Intervention Grant" for equipment; authorizing the Fire Chief through the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement or agreements to carry out the terms of the grant by purchasing the equipment necessary to carry out the purpose of the grant; authorizing the expenditure of local funds; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 364-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and to accept, if awarded, funding from the Northern Ohio Golf Charities, Inc. grant program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 365-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and to accept, if awarded, funding from the Wal-Mart Foundation grant program; and declaring an emergency. (Global Village) VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 366-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and to accept, if awarded, funding from the Wal-Mart Foundation grant program; and declaring an emergency. (Arts Expo) VOTE 13-0
- 9 RES 367-2017 expressing support for the National Park System and urging Congress to increase federal funding to properly maintain the National Parks; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 368-2017 reaffirming support and authorizing execution of an amended and restated Guaranty Agreement among the City, the County of Summit and Fifth Third Bank, in connection with the extension of certain credit facilities to Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. (the "Akron Urban League") to continue to support the Akron Urban League's community service center and for its operations; and declaring an emergency. (11/13/17)
- 11 ORD 369-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a 40-unit townhouse development at North Main Street and Olive Street; and declaring an emergency. (10/30/17) VOTE 13-0

- 12 ORD 370-2017 approving the sale of City-owned land on the east side of West Center Street to Akron Children's Hospital; determining said property is not needed for public use; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement to sell said property; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 13 RES 371-2017 appointing Zac Kohl and Ron Fowler, Jr. to the Community Reinvestment Housing Council; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
