ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED 12-4-17

- 1 ORD 376-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for proposals, for the purchase of real and personal property insurance and boiler insurance for all city properties to cover the period March 1, 2018 to March 1, 2023; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 377-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of support and hardware maintenance for three uninterruptible power supplies in three City data centers from Wadsworth Solutions; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 378-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and to accept, if awarded, funding from the Bloomberg Philanthropies, 2017 Mayors Challenge grant program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 379-2017 approving the sale of vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. - 5 ORD 380-2017 approving the sale of various City-owned properties to JAR Enterprises Ohio, LLC, determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 381-2017 authorizing the purchase of 282 ½ & VL Kelly Avenue for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 382-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the sale of trees on properties in Geauga County; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 383-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of miscellaneous materials and services needed by the Department of Public Safety and for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.
