ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED 12-11-17

- 1 ORD 392-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron/Summit Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc. to pay an operating subsidy for the convention bureau for 2017, in order to support the services and offerings of the Convention Bureau to the residents and visitors of the greater Akron area; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 393-2017 approving the sale of vacant City-owned land on the east side of West Center Street to Akron Children's Hospital; determining said property is not needed for public use; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement to sell said property; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 394-2017 the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of new equipment and lighting for the 10 new APD cruisers; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 395-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a telecommunications agreement and other related lease and assignment agreements, after publicly advertising for bids, to lease, license and/or assign cellular communications leases and rights of access on City-owned property to EIP Communications I, LLC, or its designee I "EIP"; finding said leases are not currently needed for any public use, and related findings; all in furtherance of the objectives of responsibly stabilizing the financial condition of the City of Akron and building cash reserves in order to support the effective functioning of the City in the event of an emergency; and declaring and emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 396-2017 amending Ordinance No. 42-2017, passed February 13, 2017 and Ordinance No 297-2017, passed September 25, 2017, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 397-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to place CO2 tanks at 1031 Forbes Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 398-2017 amending/supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 104 “Income Tax Ordinance,” Section 104.03 “Purposes of tax; rate” in order to update the Codified Ordinances of the City of Akron to reflect the additional 0.25% income tax levied pursuant to Section 86e of the Charter of the City of Akron, as approved by the voters on November 7, 2017; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 RES 399-2017 congratulating and honoring the 2017 East CLC football team and their coaches on winning the Akron City Series Football Championship; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 9 RES 400-2017 opposing the tax bill recently passed by the United States Senate, urging the President to veto any such legislation that comes before him, urging the President to shield Medicare, Medicaid, and Social Security from any cuts; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-1 (HOCH), (KAMMER ABSTAINED)
