**PLANNING**

0. ORDINANCE approving the 2018 Akron Neighborhood Maintenance and Empowerment Program; authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bid proposals, for services related to mowing of publicly-owned lots, workforce and skills training, and career assistance; and declaring an emergency.

**BUDGET & FINANCE**

1. ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 104 “Income Tax Ordinance” in order to reflect changes improperly mandated by Ohio House Bill 49 (HB 49), reserving the right to continue litigating an ongoing challenge to HB 49, recognizing that several provisions may be invalidated or stayed as a result of that challenge, and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE**

2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of the Canton Road Resurfacing Project, for certain improvements from the southern municipal corporation limits to Wedgewood Drive; authorizing the appropriation and/or expenditure of funds; and declaring an emergency.

3. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of advertising for bids, with MTech for the purchase of GraniteNet Inspection software and/or associated services; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SAFETY**

4. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of five (5) washer-extractors for use at Akron Fire Stations; and declaring an emergency.

5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract after accepting informal sealed bids, for the purchase of uniform materials for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

6. RESOLUTION expressing support for the enactment of Ohio Revised Code Section 5.2516, which designates the month of February as “Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month” in the State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
