PLANNING

0. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement for the sale of City-owned property and the execution of an exclusive right of way license agreement on a portion of City-owned land located between 925 and 955 Grant Street to SPI Properties; finding that the property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency.

1. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City owned land to Heather & Aaron Woodard; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

2. ORDINANCE directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by David A. White, located at 1166 5th Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with CSO Rack 3 Kelly Green Project; declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I; Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency.

3. ORDINANCE directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Tammera Pasley (fka Tammera Gaffney), located at 339 Chittenden Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with CSO Rack 3 Kelly Green Project; declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I; Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency.

4. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the Canton Road Resurfacing Project, for certain improvements and the construction of curb ramps.

5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on the Manchester Road Bridge over the ABC and CSX Railroads near Kenmore Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

7. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts for the purchase of 911 call center hardware and software on behalf of the City of Stow; and declaring an emergency.

8. RESOLUTION calling on the Ohio General Assembly to enact a ban on the sale of assault-style weapons, ammunition magazines in excess of ten rounds, and modifications that simulate automated fire such as bump stocks and trigger cranks; and declaring an emergency.

9. RESOLUTION expressing heartfelt sympathy of the City of Akron to the families and friends of the victims of the shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida; extending wishes of healing for the Stoneman Douglas community in this time of tragedy; and declaring an emergency.
