ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 12, 2018

- 1 ORD 74-2018 authorizing the Director of Finance to advertise for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, and to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of Public Employee Dishonesty and Crime Insurance for all City employees; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)

- 2 ORD 75-2018 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Plymouth Avenue, west of Cuyahoga Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)

- 3 RES 76-2018 declaring it necessary to improve Canton Road between the termini of Wedgewood Drive and the southern corporate limit and between the termini of East Market Street and State Route 76 by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)

- 4 ORD 77-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into a contract or contracts with Robert Anderson dba Anderson Lawn Care for mowing services for public property, including park property; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)

- 5 ORD 78-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of certain K-9 equipment for use in Akron Police Department cruisers; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)

- 6 RES 79-2018 endorsing the Downtown Akron Vision and Redevelopment Plan; expressing support for it as a precedent for neighborhood planning efforts; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Fusco, Neal, Omobien absent)
