### **ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 19, 2018**

- 1 ORD 80-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for grassy area restoration at various locations throughout Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 2 RES 81-2018 adopting the annual operating budget for the fiscal year 2018; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-1 (Neal) (Keith absent)
  
- 3 ORD 82-2018 to make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal abstained; Keith absent)
  
- 4 ORD 83-2018 amending/supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 104 “Income Tax Ordinance” in order to reflect changes improperly mandated by Ohio House Bill 49 (HB 49), reserving the right to continue litigating an ongoing challenge to HB 49, recognizing that several provisions may be invalidated or stayed as a result of that challenge, and declaring an emergency. (Substitute Offered as an Amendment) VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 5 ORD 84-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence at 1519 Preston Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 6 ORD 85-2018 changing the name of Greenspire Lane to Greenspire Circle in the Lake of the Woods subdivision; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)

- 7 RES 86-2018 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phases I, II and III Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 8 RES 87-2018 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, II and III Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and
  
- 9 RES 88-2018 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, II and III Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 10 ORD 89-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and enter into an agreement for funding through the Road to Zero initiative administered by the National Safety Council to secure funding for overtime and to purchase speed enforcement equipment; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
  
- 11 ORD 90-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with the Summit Soil & Water Conservation District for the Akron Waterways Renewed Rain Barrel Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
