### **ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 9, 2018**

- 1 ORD 103-2018 approving the recommendations of certain Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 2 ORD 104-2018 approving the sale of vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for a Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 3 ORD 105-2018 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 141 Marvin Ave. to B. R. Knez Construction, Inc., determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 4 ORD 106-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract and/or other related agreements with CSX Transportation for the construction of certain improvements on Evans Avenue; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 5 RES 107-2018 congratulating and honoring St. Vincent-St. Mary Boys Basketball Team ("The Fighting Irish") and their coaches on capturing the Division II State Basketball Championship for the second straight season and breaking the record for most state championships; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 6 RES 108-2018 establishing April 15, 2018, the international awareness day for Pompe Disease, as “Eyonna Rogers Day” in the City of Akron and urging all citizens to be aware of their genetic history; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 7 ORD 109-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct the Harmon Court Development on the north side of Vernon Odom Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 8 ORD 110-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a detached garage at 98 North Rose Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 9 ORD 111-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an apartment building at 2197 Eastwood Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 10 ORD 112-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the painting of fire hydrants in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-1 (Neal) (Omobien absent)
- 11 ORD 113-2018 authorizing the transfer of City-owned property to Akron Public Schools in exchange for property owned by Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 12 RES 114-2018 acknowledging the 50th anniversary of the enactment of the Fair Housing Act; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
