BUDGET & FINANCE

1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept grant funding through the 2018 Wells Fargo and U.S. Conference of Mayors Community WINS Grant Program to be utilized for funding financial counseling services at the Akron Financial Empowerment Center; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into related agreements; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING

2. ORDINANCE approving the sale of a vacant City-owned property pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
3. ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to Sweet & Buntin Real Estate Properties, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

4. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for city-wide tree removal services; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids or requesting design build proposals, for the construction of the Uhler Conveyance Project (CSO Rack 27 and 29); and declaring an emergency.
6. PUBLIC UTILITIES

7. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the rebuilding of a centrifugal blower and motor at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.
8. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with Rexel for the annual preventative maintenance of two (2) service pump variable frequency drives at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.
9. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of certain waterlines/mains throughout the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of ten (10) thermal imaging units for use by the Akron Fire Department; and declaring an emergency.
