ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 30, 2018

- 1 ORD 136-2018 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned property pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 2 ORD 137-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for city-wide tree removal services; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 3 ORD 138-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids or requesting design build proposals, for the construction of the Uhler Conveyance Project (CSO Rack 27 and 29); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 4 ORD 139-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the rebuilding of a centrifugal blower and motor at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 5 ORD 140-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with Rexel for the annual preventative maintenance of two (2) service pump variable frequency drives at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 6 ORD 141-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of certain waterlines/mains throughout the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)

- 7 ORD 142-2018 approving the addition of the property located at 20 West Waterloo Road, in Coventry Township to the Coventry-Akron Joint Economic Development District; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to amend the Coventry-Akron JEDD agreement to include the property located at 20 West Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims Abstained) (Freeman Absent)
