ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 4, 2018

- 1 ORD 177-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the replacement of the failed air conditioning unit at the Ellet Community Center; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer Abstained)

- 2 ORD 178-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the planting of trees in connection with the restoration phase of the CSO program known as "CSO Tree Planting 2018"; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer Abstained)

- 3 ORD 179-2018 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service of entering into a contract with NBW, Inc. for the emergency replacement of the boiler at Good Park Golf Course; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer Abstained)

- 4 ORD 180-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with The K Company for emergency replacement of the chilled water coils and air handler for the Stubbs Justice Center; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer Abstained)

- 5 RES 181-2018 declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency. - 8 ORD 184-2018 approving the addition of the property located at 3492 Copley Road, in Copley Township to the Copley-Akron Joint Economic Development District; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to amend the Copley-Akron JEDD agreement to include the property located at 3492 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency. - 10 ORD 186-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, in partnership with the United Way of Summit County, to apply for grant funding through the Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund to attain the 2018 Financial Empowerment Center Implementation grant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 187-2018 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Summit County and the cities of Cuyahoga Falls, Fairlawn, Green, and Stow for the acquisition, installation, and operation of a consolidated computer aided dispatch system; and declaring an emergency. - 12 ORD 188-2018 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for a certain property described below to facilitate the completion of SUM 261 Tallmadge Avenue Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 13 ORD 189-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the construction of the Kelly Conveyance (CSO Rack 3) Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 14 ORD 190-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the construction of the Chittenden Green (CSO Rack 3) Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
