**PLANNING**

1. ORDINANCE accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Coburn Street, north of West Thornton Street; and declaring an emergency.
2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into, execute and deliver a Ground Lease and Lease Agreement with the Development Finance Authority of Summit County in connection with the financing and construction of the City’s Fire Station No. 4 and new administrative facilities for the City; and declaring an emergency.
3. ORDINANCE approving and authorizing the execution of a Lease with the Board of Education of the Akron City School District for real property located on Thornton Street, in order to construct the new Fire Station No. 4, which will also house fire administration and certain countywide resources; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES**

4. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to file applications and enter into agreements with the Water Supply Revolving Loan Account for loans to fund certain Water Supply Bureau projects; designating authorized representatives for the applications; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of a new concrete tank foundation for use at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SAFETY**

6. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee, to apply for and if awarded, accept grant funding through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance as part of the National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative to address cold case sexual assault matters; and declaring an emergency.

**PARKS & RECREATION**

7. ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with KaBOOM, Inc. and the United Way of Summit County for the creation of a playground located at Prentiss Park; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.
