ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 11, 2018

- 1 ORD 193-2018 accepting a vacation plat for Ellsworth Court, south of Kenmore Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 2 ORD 194-2018 accepting a dedication plat for Cole Avenue Extension; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 3 ORD 195-2018 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 4 ORD 196-2018 approving the sale of City-owned land; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 5 ORD 197-2018 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development or his designee to enter into contracts with non-profit neighborhood-based organizations for the provision of services, including, among other things, neighborhood events, community gardens and beautification projects, after school programs and mentoring programs, authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 6 ORD 198-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent or her designee to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for street tree trimming services; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 7 ORD 199-2018 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2017 Phase I Arterial/Collector Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)

- 8 ORD 200-2018 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2017 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 9 ORD 201-2018 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2017 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Neal Abstained) (Kilby Absent)
- 10 ORD 202-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publically advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of certain projects on Evans Avenue from Home Avenue to 400 feet east of Shreve Road; and declaring an emergency. - 11 ORD 203-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, to furnish Engineered Wood Fiber Surfacing at various locations in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. - 12 ORD 204-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into Sponsorship Agreements with the Appalachia Ohio Alliance for the Utzinger Bog Project and the Big Darby Creek Conservation Corridor Initiative; with the Twin City Water & Sewer District for the Uhrichsville Lowhead Dam Removal; and with the Stark County Park District for the Nimisila Creek Preserve Phase 2; and declaring an emergency. - 13 ORD 205-2018 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Retail Business Use District Classification (U3, H2, A3) Use on property located on the east side of South Arlington Street, south of Palmetto Avenue and west of Modena Drive, aka Parcel Nos. 6763734 and 6763755, to a Commercial Use District Classification (U4, H1, A2) Use; and declaring an emergency. - 16 ORD 208-2018 amending and/or supplementing Title 5 “Public Works”, Chapter 52 “Garbage and Refuse”, Section 52.14 “Service charge”; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-3 (Milkovich, Neal, Sims) (Kilby Absent)
- 17 ORD 209-2018 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with KaBOOM, Inc. and the United Way of Summit County for the creation of a playground located at Prentiss Park; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kilby Absent)
