**BUDGET & FINANCE:**

1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to accept a grant award for the Akron PeaceMakers Project funded through the U.S. Conference of Mayor’s DollarWise: Mayor’s for Financial Literacy Initiative; authorizing expenditure of funds on identified programs to promote financial literacy; and declaring an emergency. (\$10,000 grant, no match)
2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, for back-up software for the Citywide Data Center from Software House International Corporation; and declaring an emergency.
- 2A. ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$2,000,000, for the purpose acquiring a perpetual easement in the building known as the Lock 4 Arcade within the Bowery Development in furtherance of economic development purposes of the City; and declaring an emergency.

**PLANNING**

3. ORDINANCE approving the sale of certain vacant City-owned properties at 202/204 (VL) E. Miller Avenue pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. (Substitute offered as an Amendment)
4. ORDINANCE accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Pine Alley; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned land located at 132 Willard Avenue; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency.
6. ORDINANCE declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, requiring the owners of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes; establishing a municipal public improvement tax increment equivalent fund for the deposit of such service payments, and related authorizations pursuant to Sections 5709.40, 5709.42 and 5709.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorizing the execution and delivery of a Redevelopment and Tax Increment

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Financing Agreement with Akron Romig Road LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“Developer”); authorizing the execution and delivery of a Purchase and Sale Contract with the Developer to sell certain real property owned by the City; finding that said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE**

7. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Kingswood Drive between the termini of Merriman Road and Rocky Hollow Drive, and Rocky Hollow Drive between the termini of Kingswood Drive and Rocky Ridge Drive by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees, all together with the necessary appurtenances; and declaring an emergency.
8. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Wilbeth Road between the termini of Dallas Avenue and Interstate 77 by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees, all together with the necessary appurtenances; and declaring an emergency.
9. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“OEPA”) for clean air grant funding through the State of Ohio’s Diesel Mitigation Trust Fund Program; authorizing local match requirements for the same; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES:**

10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts to construct Eckert Ditch water-quality improvements; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:**

11. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into agreements with various political subdivisions in the County of Summit for the provision of Prosecutorial Services; and declaring an emergency.
