### ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 16, 2018

- 1 ORD 243-2018 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, or his designee, to enter into agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Solutions Grant Program for program year 2018 in support of local emergency and transitional homeless shelters in order to provide shelter and supportive services to homeless individuals and families; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 2 ORD 244-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with E&S Supply for the emergency repair of the Thurmont Road storm outlet; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 3 ORD 245-2018 declaring the necessity of and determining to proceed with the improvement of Cole Avenue Extension in the City by paving, grading, constructing, reconstructing and installing curbs, concrete sidewalks, storm sewers, storm sewer laterals, sanitary sewers, sanitary sewer laterals, water main and water main laterals, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; all in accordance with the Petition submitted by the property owner of the benefitted property; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 4 ORD 246-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of improvements for the Safe Routes to School Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 5 ORD 247-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with the Akron Legal News for the advertisement/placement of legal notices associated with the City of Akron's Street Lighting and Cleaning Assessments; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)

- 6 ORD 248-2018 amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code", Section 153.296 "Biomedical Use District – Class UB" by expanding permitted uses allowed; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 249-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 545 Castle Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 250-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a storage building at 1623 East Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 251-2018 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 630 & 642 Diagonal Rd. to B.R. Knez Construction, Inc. in order to promote new housing construction in keeping with Mayor Horrigan's "Planning to Grow Akron" strategy for increasing the City's population and revitalizing its neighborhoods; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Milkovich abstained)
- 10 ORD 252-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a single-family detached allotment on the northwest side of Diagonal Road, south of Copley Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Milkovich abstained)
- 11 ORD 253-2018 declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, requiring the owners of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes; establishing a municipal public improvement tax increment equivalent fund for the deposit of such service payments, and related authorizations pursuant to Sections 5709.40, 5709.42 and 5709.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorizing the execution and delivery of a Redevelopment and Tax Increment Financing Agreement with Akron Romig Road LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Developer"); authorizing the execution and delivery of a Purchase and Sale Contract with the Developer to sell certain real property owned by the City; finding that said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-1 (Milkovich)
- 12 ORD 254-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("OEPA") for clean air grant funding through the State of Ohio's Diesel Mitigation Trust Fund Program; authorizing local match requirements for the same; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
