ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 30, 2018

- 1 ORDINANCE NO. 275-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$2,000,000, for the purpose acquiring a perpetual easement in the building known as the Lock 4 Arcade within the Bowery Development in furtherance of economic development purposes of the City; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 2 ORDINANCE NO. 276-2018 approving the Romig Road Redevelopment Plan; making necessary findings in connection therewith; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 3 ORDINANCE NO. 277-2018 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 428 and 432 Crouse Street; authorizing the execution of related agreements; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 4 ORDINANCE NO. 278-2018 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 11 W. Emerling Avenue & VL S. Main Street; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 5 ORDINANCE NO. 279-2018 approving the sale of City-owned property located at 402 Grand Avenue; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 6 ORDINANCE NO. 280-2018 authorizing the purchase of various interests in real property located in or around N. Case Avenue to facilitate the completion of the CSO Rack 10/11 (Storage Basin) Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; authorizing payment for the same; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 7 ORDINANCE NO. 281-2018 approving the sale of city owned land to NSA Holdings, LLC for urban redevelopment; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 8 ORDINANCE NO. 282-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) vendors for the purchase of fire hydrants and restraining gland kits in conjunction with certain Ohio Public Works Commission requirements; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 9 ORDINANCE NO. 283-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and grant a pipeline easement on City-owned property to Troy NGP Ltd.; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 10 ORDINANCE NO. 284-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly requesting qualifications and proposals, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of Hazel Storage Basin (CSO Rack 10 and 11) through a construction manager at risk; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 11 ORDINANCE NO. 285-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts after publicly advertising for bids, for the repair and/or replacement of certain filter boxes at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 10-0 (Kammer abstained; Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 12 Ordinance NO. 286-2018 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. Vote:11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 13 Ordinance No. 287-2018 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; accepting the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 14 Ordinance No. 288-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for resurfacing certain streets and for certain bridge improvements ; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 15 Ordinance No. 289-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on US-224; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 16 Ordinance No. 290-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on State Routes 18 and 261; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 17 Ordinance No. 291-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into contracts with FCX Performance, Inc., for the purchase of 20-inch valve gearbox assemblies for large-diameter valves for use in the City's water supply system; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)

- 18 Resolution No. 292-2018 opposing and objecting to the renewal applications of Grant Street Tavern, LLC, 1307 Grant Street, Akron, Ohio 44301 for Class D5 and D6 liquor permits (3327478 and 33274780005) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 19 Resolution No. 293-2018 opposing and objecting to the renewal application of LG & H ENT, LLC, D/B/A Game 7 Bar & Grille, 1st Floor & Patio, 627 S. Arlington Street, Akron, Ohio 44306 for the transfer of a Class D5 liquor permit (5180405) to be pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0 (Samples & Swirsky absent)
- 20 Resolution No. 294-2018 opposing the proposed changes in federal regulations governing the Title X National Family Planning Program; declaring support for access to all legal family planning services and related counseling; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 9-2 (Freeman & Hoch) (Samples & Swirsky absent)

ITEMS THAT DID NOT PASS AT SPECIAL MEETING AUGUST 20, 2018:

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the submission to the electors of the City of Akron a proposal to amend Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Akron, to establish a May primary election date for municipal elections in the City of Akron, in order to reduce the cost of the primary election for Akron taxpayers and uphold the voting rights of military service members, to be voted upon at the next regular City-wide election on November 6, 2018; and declaring an emergency. (7/9/18) (Note: On 7/23/18, a Substitute Offered as an Amendment was read in) (RULES)
- 2 Ordinance authorizing and directing the submission to the electors of the City of Akron a proposal to amend Sections 3 and 4 of the Charter of the City of Akron, to replace the municipal primary elections with nomination petitions and establish nonpartisan municipal elections in the City of Akron, in order to eliminate the cost of the primary election for Akron taxpayers, increase voter participation in the general election, uphold the voting rights of military service members, and improve government accountability to be voted upon at the next regular City-wide election on November 6, 2018; and declaring an emergency.
