### ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 17, 2018

- 1 ORDINANCE NO. 301-2018 approving the recommendations of certain Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 2 ORDINANCE NO. 302-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 3 ORDINANCE NO. 303-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent or her designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Aggreko, LLC for the rental of a chiller for the ice rink in Lock 3; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 4 ORDINANCE NO. 304-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for temporary concrete installation over excavations of the Divisions of Water Distribution and Sewer Maintenance prior to final pavement surface repairs by the Division of Highway Maintenance; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 5 ORDINANCE NO. 305-2018 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with H.M. Miller Construction Company, Core & Main, and Thompson Pipe Products for the emergency repair of a 48-inch water main in Reservoir Park on Brittain Road; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 6 ORDINANCE NO. 306-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent or her designee to enter into a contract or contracts, without publicly advertising

for bids, with Key Tracer Systems, Inc for the purchase of a Key Tracer System and Locker; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0

- 7 ORDINANCE NO. 307-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, the 2018 Judicial Assistance Grant administered through the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance designed to provide law enforcement agencies with the flexibility to prioritize and utilize justice funds where they are needed most; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 8 ORDINANCE NO. 308-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use in order to establish two single-family dwellings at 436 N. Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 9 ORDINANCE NO. 309-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana dispensary at 46 South Summit Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 12-0
- 10 RESOLUTION No. 310-2018 approving the application of Stephen and Janice Brown to have agricultural property on Diagonal Road to be included in an "agricultural district" pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 11 Resolution No. 310-2018 approving the new application of Stephen Brown to place property at 590 Diagonal Road in an agricultural district pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01. VOTE: 12-0
- 12 ORDINANCE NO. 311-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to file an application with assurances and certifications with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Continuum of Care Application for Stewart B. McKinney funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 13 Resolution No. 312-2018 expressing support for continued efforts, funding, and actions on the part of the City of Akron to address and combat homelessness; acknowledging the dedication and efforts of the Akron/Summit County Continuum of Care and other Akron-related charitable and beneficent organizations, including The Homeless Charity, in the fight against homelessness; encouraging continued discussions and collaboration between the City of Akron and The Homeless Charity; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 14 ORDINANCE No. 313-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, grant funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety to be used for the continuation and/or implementation of the Impaired Driving Enforcement Program (IDEP) and/or the Selective

Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0

- 15 ORDINANCE NO. 314-2018 re-authorizing the My Neighborhood Our Akron City Council Grant Agreement Program, through which neighborhood-based organizations in each ward in the City are eligible for small grants in a total amount not to exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) per ward; authorizing the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into grant agreements with neighborhood-based organizations to carry out the purposes of the Program; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 11-0
