BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 82-2018, passed March 19, 2018, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018; and declared an emergency.

PLANNING

- 2 RESOLUTION approving and confirming the re-appointment of Bruce Bolden to the City Board of Zoning Appeals; approving and confirming the appointments of Candice Eberhardt, Perry Clark, and Sara Avalos to the City Board of Zoning Appeals; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 ORDINANCE approving the sale of vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to D&P of Ohio Partnership and Braymor Development, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

- 5 ORDINANCE approving the donation of city owned land to the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to Brian and Natalie Caperones; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to IRG RC 110 GY, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to accept title and ownership of certain real property near Romig Road, in order to provide for the future redevelopment and productive reuse of the property; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE authorizing the transfer of city owned property on Sumner and Allyn Streets to Akron Public Schools in exchange for property owned by Akron Public Schools on Dayton Street; and declaring an emergency.
- 10 RESOLUTION approving and confirming the re-appointments of David Hawkins and Charlie Ryder to the Urban Design and Historic Preservation Commission; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 11 ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Liberta Construction for the emergency repair of the trunk sewer located near the intersection of Mull Avenue and Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Kustom Signals, Inc. for the purchase of ten (10) ProLaser 4 bundles for use by the City of Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency.
- 13 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to accept an Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the Department of Homeland Security for the purchase of a new fire-related vehicle; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds from the appropriate account or accounts; authorizing the purchase of said vehicle after publicly advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.
- 14 ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 7, "Traffic Code," Chapter 76, "Parking Regulations," Section 76.221, "Parking Large

Vehicles in Residence Districts” by updating limitations on what kind of large vehicles may be allowed to park in residential districts; and declaring an emergency.

PARKS & RECREATION

- 15 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, grant funds from the Northern Ohio Golf Charities Foundation for repairs and additions to facilities at Hardesty Park; and declaring an emergency.
- 16 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the redesign, repair, update, addition and/or improvement of grounds, equipment, and facilities/fixtures at certain City of Akron Parks in keeping with the Akron Parks Challenge; and declaring an emergency.

HOUSING

- 17 RESOLUTION approving and confirming the re-appointment of Michael Dobbertin to the Housing Appeals Board; and declaring an emergency.

HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE

- 18 RESOLUTION approving and confirming the re-appointments of Jim Perge, Harvey Sterns, and Susan Sigmon to the Senior Citizens Commission; and declaring an emergency.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & JOB CREATION

- 19 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept \$250,000 in grant funds through the Summit County Transportation Improvement District, awarded by the Ohio Department of Transportation’s Office of Jobs and Commerce, for the improvement of the Firestone Business Park; and declaring an emergency.
