ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 15, 2018

- 1 ORD 337-2018 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declared an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 RES 338-2018 requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2018 payable in 2019 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 339-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$30,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of various improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 340-2018 providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$498,412.45 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 341-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$5,950,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, and otherwise improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 342-2018 providing for the issuance and sale of notes in a principal amount not exceeding \$13,500,000 to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 343-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$600,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system in

the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 344-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities in the City by constructing, reconstructing, renovating, repairing roofs, remodeling, relocating, making site and other improvements, planning and designing facilities and acquiring and installing related equipment, all as applicable, designated or to be designated by the Director of Public Services; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 345-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,900,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for certain Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 346-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$550,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of certain economic development projects in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 347-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,300,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of the City's portion of the consolidated Computer Aided Dispatch system being purchased by Summit County in connection with dispatch services for the City's safety forces; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 ORD 348-2018 providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,911,180.55 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 13 ORD 349-2018 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Wheeler Lane, north of East Market Street and authorizing the President of Council and the Clerk of Council to endorse the acceptance by Council; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 14 ORD 350-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of State Route 91, State Route 224, and Canton Road (PID 89113); declaring said project to be in the public interest; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 15 ORD 351-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee,

after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of sodium hypochlorite for disinfection at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 16 ORD 352-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to install a digital billboard along I-77 at 530 Nome Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 17 ORD 353-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a storage building at 2822 Albrecht Avenue, involving both Albrecht Avenue and Alpha Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 18 RES 354-2018 approving and confirming the re-appointments of Jim Perge, Harvey Sterns, and Susan Sigmon to the Senior Citizens Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
