RULES

- 0 ORDINANCE repealing Title 11, Chapter 110, “Business Regulations,” Section 110.31, “Polygraph Tests” of the Akron Codified Ordinances; and declaring an emergency.
- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept \$25,000 in grant funds through the Better Future platform, awarded by Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, for promoting safe mobility, inspiring students to reach their full potential, and reducing environmental impact; and declaring an emergency.
- 2 RESOLUTION recognizing and celebrating the 50th anniversary of The Reporter Newspaper; and declaring an emergency.
- 3. ORDINANCE amending and supplementing Title 3, “Administration,” Chapter 38, “Unlawful Discrimination,” of the Akron Codified Ordinances; and declaring an emergency.

BUDGET & FINANCE

- 3A ORDINANCE approving and authorizing the expenditure of \$10,000 previously designated for My Neighborhood, Our Akron for the purchase of one-year subscriptions of the Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software as approved in Ordinance No. 100-2018.

PLANNING

- 4 RESOLUTION approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of Scott Rowland, Lauren Alexander, Greg Burke, Ellis W. Polk, and Renee M. Nied to the Vacant Commercial or Industrial Building Appeals Board; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the sale of certain vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 ORDINANCE authorizing the sale of 860 Aberdeen Street; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
