RULES

- 1 RESOLUTION recognizing and celebrating the 50th anniversary of The Reporter Newspaper, and declaring an emergency.

BUDGET & FINANCE

- 2 ORDINANCE providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 ORDINANCE approving and authorizing the expenditure of \$10,000 previously designated for My Neighborhood, Our Akron for the purchase of one-year subscriptions of the Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software as approved in Ordinance No. 100-2018; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING

- 4 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts to purchase the property located at 201 S. Main Str., Akron, OH 44308, known as the Carlton Building, from JMS Place Limited (“JMS”) and then immediately sell it to Pritt Properties, LLC (“Pritt”), allowing Pritt to carry out the Downtown Renewal Plan as set forth in Ordinance No. 255-2014; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the purchase of vacant lots on Kelly Avenue and Weeks Street for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; and declaring an emergency.

- 6 ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned property located at 146 South High Street, Akron, OH 44308; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a lease agreement with Stark State College to lease City-owned land at the Akron Fulton Airport for use as a commercial driver's license driving school; and declaring an emergency.
- 7A ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 15 "Land Usage", Chapter 153 "Zoning Code", Section 153.140 "Definitions" by defining supportive housing and Section 153.305(F) "Private Parking for Residence Occupants" by revising the amount of required off-street residential parking requirements; and declaring an emergency.
