**BUDGET & FINANCE**

- 1        ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts with United Way of Summit County to implement the 2018 Financial Empowerment Center Implementation Grant from the Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 2        ORDINANCE repealing and replacing Ordinance No. 316-2017, creating, establishing, and recognizing departments, offices, bureaus, divisions and positions in the classified service of the City of Akron; requiring that only budgeted funded positions be filled; and declaring an emergency.

- 3        ORDINANCE approving the sale of certain City-owned land located in the Hickory Urban Renewal Area to Cascade Valley, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 4        ORDINANCE approving the sale of certain vacant City-owned property at VL East Exchange Street pursuant to the Economic Development Land Banking Program; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 5        ORDINANCE approving the sale of certain vacant City-owned property located between Pitkin Street and Dayton Street pursuant to the Land Banking Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

- 6 ORDINANCE approving the donation of certain vacant City-owned property from the Land Banking Project to Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 ORDINANCE approving the sale of certain vacant City-owned property at 986 (VL) Leroy Street pursuant to the Land Reutilization Program; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE approving the donation of certain City-owned property located at 411 Ira Avenue to Summit County Metro Parks pursuant to the Land Banking Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE approving the donation of certain City-owned property located on Ira Avenue to the Summit County Metro Parks, pursuant to the Land Reutilization Program; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 9A ORDINANCE declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Amended Airport Development Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.
- 9B ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_-2018 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Firestone North Urban Renewal Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.

## PUBLIC SERVICE
