RULES

- 1 ORDINANCE enacting Title 3 “Administration,” Article 3 “Appeals,” Section 31.99 “Appeals” of the Akron Code of Ordinances to explicitly authorize the Mayor or his designee to appeal the adverse decision of an administrative body; and declaring an emergency.

BUDGET & FINANCE

- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for its expungement program in 2019; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 ORDINANCE approving the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District Petition and the Services Plan to be provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc.; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 ORDINANCE approving and authorizing the expenditure of \$10,000 previously designated for the Akron City Council travel budget be reallocated to the Akron Cares Program; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of a 700 GPM grease pump for the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES

- 6 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the installation of water mains on Druid Drive, Hammond Boulevard, Raleigh Boulevard, Schoolcraft Avenue, and Cleveland-Massillon Road as a part of the Druid Drive Neighborhood Water Main Extension Regionalization Project; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, for up to a three-year maintenance agreement with Itron for the testing, repair and replacement of existing handheld AMR meter reading field collector units; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an agreement with the City of Hudson to define the cost sharing responsibilities in the restoration of Middleton Road; authorizing compensation/reimbursement to the City of Hudson in accordance with such agreement; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE prohibiting and City of Akron utility bill to exceed one hundred-fifty percent (150%) of the average of the previous twelve (12) monthly bills provided that the excess water usage was not intended by the property owner.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, with Westnet, Inc. for the purchase of Fire Station alerting hardware, software, and services for use at all Akron Fire Stations; and declaring an emergency.

PARKS & RECREATION

- 11 RESOLUTION congratulating the 2018 University of Akron Zips men's soccer team for a remarkable season and competing in the 2018 NCAA Division 1 national championship (College Cup) for the sixth time in program history; commending the players, their coaches, staff, administrators, and fans, and wishing the team well in 2019; and declaring an emergency.
