### BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency.

### PLANNING

- 1A RESOLUTION approving the renewal application of Evelia Ramos to have agricultural property at 1080 St. Michaels Avenue placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/7/19)
- 2 RESOLUTION approving, with modification, the renewal application of Donald E. and Carol A. Bessemer to have agricultural property on 1543 Collier Road and 1456 St. Michaels Avenue placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/7/19)
- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a group home at 85 Kent Place; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/7/19)
- 4 RESOLUTION adopting the 2019 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, legally referred to as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/14/19)

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 1536 Breiding Road; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/14/19)
- 6 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana processing facility at 844 E. Tallmadge Avenue; and declaring an emergency. . (Public Hearing scheduled for 1/14/19)
- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a lease agreement with the Genesis Outdoor Advertising to lease City-owned land at 530 Nome Avenue to install and maintain a digital billboard; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to execute an option agreement and related agreements with Shin-Etsu Silicones of America, Inc., for the sale of 41.85 acres of City-owned land; determining the property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a lease agreement with the Akron Zoological Park to lease City-owned land at 500 Edgewood Avenue to operate a zoo; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE**

- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with a parking management company for the management and operation of parking services for the City of Akron’s parking decks, surface lots, and on-street parking meters; and declaring an emergency.
- 11 ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Perram Electric for the emergency repair and replacement of the home-run wiring for the runway lights of Runway 7-25 at the Akron Fulton Airport; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.
- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Finance, and the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various divisions and departments of the City

for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

- 13 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement or agreements, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of miscellaneous supplies, services, repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions and departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC UTILITIES

- 14 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the replacement of water mains owned and operated by the City of Akron in Hudson, Ohio, on St. Regis Boulevard, St. Ives Boulevard, Hudson Park Drive, and Hudson-Aurora Road; and declaring an emergency.
