ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 11, 2019

- 1 ORD 37-2019 approving and confirming the appointments of Mayor Daniel Horrigan, Councilman Zack Milkovich, and Director Diane Miller-Dawson as trustees to the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board and Jim Hall, Robert Harris and Cindy Donel as their respective alternates, for terms ending February 28, 2022; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 2 ORD 38-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent or her designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the demolition and removal of an existing duplex house at the Akron Water Plant, 1570 Ravenna Road in Kent, Ohio; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 3 ORD 39-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a new office building and signage at 544 White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 4 ORD 40-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a Chipotle Mexican Grill at the northeast corner of the intersection of George Washington Boulevard and E. Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 5 ORD 41-2019 adopting the 2019 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, legally referred to as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 6 ORD 42-2019 authorizing the Mayor to enter into, execute and deliver a Guaranty Agreement in connection with the issuance by the Development Finance Authority of Summit County of revenue bonds for the benefit of Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc.; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)
- 7 ORD 43-2019 ratifying the entering into of a contract with Malwarebytes Inc. for a three-year security subscription; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith absent)

- 8 RES 44-2019 approving and confirming the appointments of Mayor Daniel Horrigan, John Moore, Thomas Tatum, Helen Tomic, Councilwoman Veronica Sims, , and Councilmen Bob Hoch and Rich Swirsky for the year 2019 as members of the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization, with alternates Samuel DeShazor (Mayor Horrigan), Jim Ashley (Tatum), Michelle DiFiore (Moore) and Abraham Wescott (Tomic); and declaring an emergency. - 9 ORD 45-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into a contract or contracts after advertising for bids for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2019 Resurfacing Program – Arterial & Collector Street Resurfacing, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.
