### RULES

- 1 RESOLUTION acknowledging the accomplishments and career of James Ingram; expressing condolences and sympathy to the family of James Ingram on his passing; and declaring an emergency.

### BUDGET & FINANCE

- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a cooperative agreement with the County of Summit for the continued collaboration between the City and the County to share office services at a joint Copy Center; and declaring an emergency.

### PLANNING

- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 515 Merriman Road; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing Scheduled for 3/11/19)
- 4 ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, “Zoning Code”, Section 153.280 “Retail Business districts” by eliminating motor vehicle sales and Section 153.285 “Commercial districts” by adding motor vehicle sales; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing Scheduled for 3/11/19)
- 5 ORDINANCE declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Ascot Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment

of a portion of the service payments to the Woodridge Local School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC SERVICE

- 6 RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.
- 7 RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency
- 8 RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with S.A. Comunale Co., Inc. for the repair/maintenance of the fire sprinkler system in Canal Park Stadium; and declaring an emergency.
- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, in furtherance of the City’s efforts to advance public health and improve services, to enter into a contract with Sourcewell, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of Toter Incorporated’s trash and recycle carts and associated repair and replacement parts for use by the Public Works Bureau; and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC UTILITIES

- 11 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with Rexel for the annual preventative maintenance of two (2) service pump variable frequency drives at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.
- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, for miscellaneous concrete work, storm sewer improvements, and asphalt work, all to be completed at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.
