ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 11, 2019

- 1 ORD 66-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a cooperative agreement with the County of Summit for the continued collaboration between the City and the County to share office services at a joint Copy Center; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 2 ORD 67-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with S.A. Comunale Co., Inc. for the repair/maintenance of the fire sprinkler system in Canal Park Stadium; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 3 ORD 68-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, in furtherance of the City's efforts to advance public health and improve services, to enter into a contract with Sourcewell, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of Toter Incorporated's trash and recycle carts and associated repair and replacement parts for use by the Public Works Bureau; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 4 ORD 69-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with Rexel for the annual preventative maintenance of two (2) service pump variable frequency drives at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 5 ORD 70-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, for miscellaneous concrete work, storm sewer improvements, and asphalt work, all to be completed at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 6 ORD 71-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 515 Merriman Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)

- 7 ORD 72-2019 amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code", Section 153.280 "Retail Business districts" by eliminating motor vehicle sales and Section 153.285 "Commercial districts" by adding motor vehicle sales; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 8 RES 73-2019 delaring it necessary to improve Romig Road between the termini of I-76 and Vernon Odom Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes and street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Neal, Samples absent)
- 9 ORD 74-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Safety, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with Grayshift GrayKey Online for hardware to bypass passcode/security on Apple devices; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Neal, Samples absent) (Sims abstained)
- 10 ORD 75-2019 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance or his designee to enter into a contract or contracts with the Northeast Ohio Basketball Association for the management, promotion and operation of The Dru Joyce Classic; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Neal, Samples absent) (Omobien abstained)
