- 1 ORD 101-2019 approving the sale of 60 Elinor Ave. to Just G LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-1 (Neal)
- 2 ORD 102-2019 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into an agreement for title, appraisal and review appraisal services and Acquisition/Relocation Consultant services to carry out the Community Development Program, and other programs; and declaring an emergency.
