BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in the Ohio Municipal League and the National League of Cities; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING

- 2 ORDINANCE declaring improvements to certain real property located in the Eastgate Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; declaring that construction and rehabilitation of certain real property is a public purpose; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the Urban Redevelopment Tax Increment Equivalent Fund; providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the replacement of the rear parking lot of Fire Station 13; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with S.A. Communale Company, Inc. for the emergency repair of the sprinkler system at the Morley Parking Deck; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 5 ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 446-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, with Westnet, Inc. for the purchase of Fire Station alerting hardware, software, and services for use at all Akron Fire Stations, to authorize the expenditure of additional funds; and declaring an emergency.

- 6 RESOLUTION opposing and objecting to the application of Family Dollar Stores of Ohio, Inc., D/B/A Family Dollar 5303, 970 Copley Road, Akron, Ohio 44320 for a Class C1 and C2 liquor permit (26312753005) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.

PARKS & RECREATION

- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Akron City School District to provide meal preparation and delivery services as part of the City's annual Summer Food Service Program; and declaring an emergency.

- 8 RESOLUTION congratulating Jacob and Jordan Decatur for a remarkable wrestling season and for three consecutive state titles while competing for Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy (CVCA); commending the wrestlers, their coaches, staff, administrators, and fans, and wishing Jacob and Jordan well as they embark on a new chapter of their lives at The Ohio State University; and declaring an emergency.
