ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 15, 2019

- 1 ORD 111-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into contracts using Community University Education Purchasing Association (CUE) bids, Sourcewell (formerly NPJA bids) bids, Omnia Public Partners Public Sector bids, or State of Ohio bids, or after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various vehicles and equipment; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky absent)

- 2 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into a contract and make payment to the City of Fairlawn for concrete and asphalt pavement restoration completed by the City of Fairlawn; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky absent)

- 3 ORD 113-2019 amending Ordinance No. 446-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, with Westnet, Inc. for the purchase of Fire Station alerting hardware, software, and services for use at all Akron Fire Stations, to authorize the expenditure of additional funds; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky absent)

- 4 RES 114-2019 opposing and objecting to the application of Family Dollar Stores of Ohio, Inc., D/B/A Family Dollar 5303, 970 Copley Road, Akron, Ohio 44320 for a Class C1 and C2 liquor permit (26312753005) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky absent)

- 5 RES 115-2019 congratulating Jacob and Jordan Decatur for a remarkable wrestling season and for three consecutive state titles while competing for Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy (CVCA); commending the wrestlers, their coaches, staff, administrators, and fans, and wishing Jacob and Jordan well as they embark on a new chapter of their lives at The Ohio State University; and declaring an emergency.
