BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of sewer and water line insurance; and declaring an emergency.
- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance, or her designee, to pay \$50,000 to support the planning and implementation of the 2019 Akron International Soap Box Derby; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING

- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, or his designee, to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend funding from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources NatureWorks Program for the construction of a water splash pad at Patterson Park; authorizing the additional expenditure of funds; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 ORDINANCE authorizing the execution of a development agreement with Bridgestone Americas Tire Operations, LLC; providing for the acquisition, sale and redevelopment of property in the Firestone Park Urban Redevelopment Area; finding such Property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 5 ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I and II Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

- 6 ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, II and III Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface; and declaring an emergency.

- 7 ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, II and III Arterial/Collector Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts with Cascade Valley, LLC, for the construction of roadway, storm and sanitary sewers, and water mains as part of the Hickory Street Phase 3 development; and declaring an emergency.

- 9 ORDINANCE determining to proceed with the improvement of Tallmadge Avenue between the termini of North Main Street and Gorge Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES

- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publically advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase and installation of a new water pump and motor at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

- 11 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publically advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts to construct an enhanced raw water pre-treatment facility; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to apply for and if awarded, accept grant funding through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance to support the Akron Sexual Assault Kit Initiative; and declaring an emergency.

- 13 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend Project Safe Neighborhoods funding from the Northern Ohio Violent Crime Consortium to support the Akron Strategic Hotspot Initiative; and declaring an emergency.
