AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 8, 2019

- 1 ORD 197-2019 approving the sale of City-owned property located at 1024 Delia Ave. to Michael A. and Julie A. White; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 2 ORD 198-2019 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts with KaBOOM!, Inc., the United Way of Summit County, Keurig Doctor Pepper, the Knight Foundation, and the Ohio & Erie Canal Corridor Coalition for the creation of a playground located at Park East; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 3 ORD 199-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file applications and to enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements under the Ohio Public Works Commission's Local Transportation Improvement Program and the State Capital Improvements Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 4 ORD 200-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into a Consent Agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the signage replacement on various routes throughout the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 5 ORD 201-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for construction of the Vernon Odom Boulevard and Interstate 77 Interchange; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)

- 6 ORD 202-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent or her designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the demolition and removal of an existing house at East Branch Reservoir, 13459 Old State Road, Huntsburg, OH 44046; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 7 ORD 203-20169 authorizing the Mayor or his designee, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter in a contract or contracts with Document Technology Systems, Ltd., for the purchase of document-knowledge-transfer software for use by the Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 8 ORD 204-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain an over-height playhouse structure at 2169 Daniels Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 9 ORD 205-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day-care business center at 1232 Honodle Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 10 ORD 2016-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a hospice home center at 475 N. Howard Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 11 ORD 207-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized accessory use structure (hoop house) at 240 E. Tallmadge Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 12 ORD 208-2019 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement or agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Solutions Grant Program for program year 2019; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 13 ORD 2019-2019 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Ohio Edison Company for the emergency replacement of the transformer at the Oxbow Ball Fields located at 1199 Cuyahoga Street; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
- 14 RES 210-2019 opposing and objecting to the renewal application of Spot for Entertainment, LLC, 935 Brown Street, Akron, Ohio 44311, for a Class D1, D2, D3 and D3A liquor permit (8442512) now pending before the Ohio Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.
